

Library Extension – Chrome Browse Extension

This easy to set up feature lets you see books available at your local library as you browse the internet. Allowing you to be taken straight to your library catalogue from sites like FantasticFiction, Goodreads, Book depository and more.

Is Library Extension for Chrome good for me?

If you are constantly browsing new books online? Do you like sharing your favourite books with your friends on Goodreads? With the Library Extension for Chrome, you can see books available in your library catalogue when browsing sites like FantasticFiction, Goodreads, Book depository & Amazon.

Then YES, this is a great way to see if recently released books are in our catalogue, or to borrow the books on your Goodreads reading list. Once displayed in the catalogue, you are one click away from placing a hold on your book of choice.


How does it work?

Library Extension is an extension for the Google Chrome web browser. An extension is a program which attaches to your web browser.

How do I get it?

1. Open your Chrome web browser  and go to [libraryextension.com](https://www.libraryextension.com)

2. Click the “Install on Chrome” button.



3. On the next screen, click the “Add to Chrome” button.





4. You may see a box asking if you would like to ‘Add Library Extension?’ Select ‘Add extension’.



5. You’ll notice a small grey icon in the top right corner of your browser.


You will either see a pile of books or a puzzle piece, like this  or this .

If you see the puzzle piece, click on this to pin the Book icon.

6. Click on the Book icon to set up for library of choice. Select “New Zealand”, “Waikato” and Matamata-Piako District Libraries from the drop down menus and click ADD.

7. Go to BookDepository.com or Goodreads.com. When you search for a book, you’ll notice a box that letting you know if the book is available.

Clicking on “borrow” will take you to the library catalogue, where you can see where the book is available, or place a hold through the library catalogue. See example below.

- Try navigating through the different editions available. If it's not available in paperback, it may be available in hardcover!
